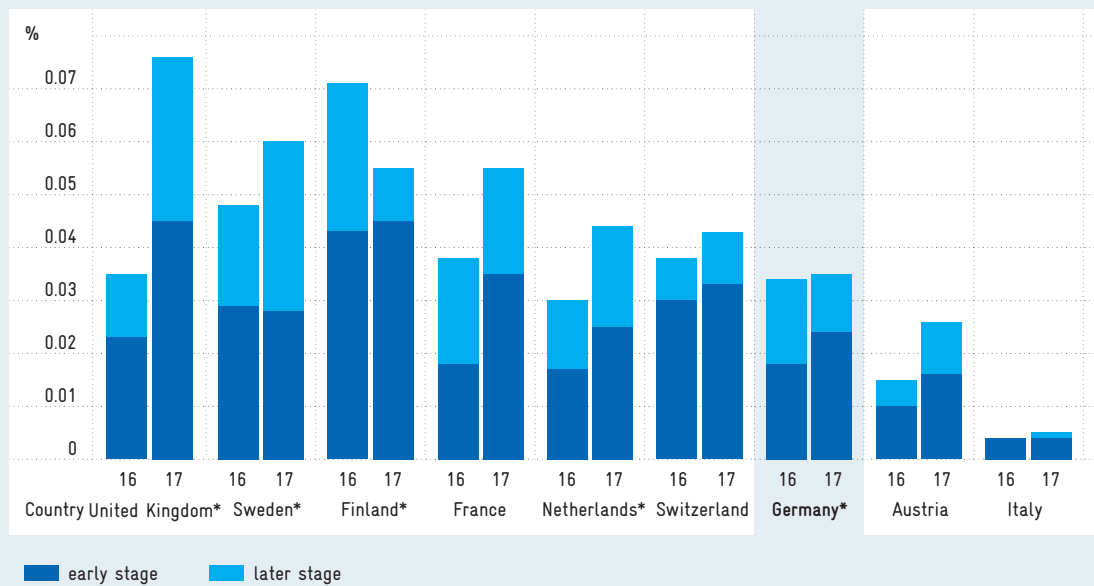


Venture-capital investment as a percentage of national GDP in 2016 and 2017
